# **Description:**

A solvent-based, black bituminous adhesive. The product is supplied ready to use and must not be diluted or heated.

# Uses

A cold applied bitumen solution for bonding mineral aggregate to mastic asphalt or built up felt roofing. It is ready to use and is ideal for bonding chippings to roofs that are flat or of low pitch (gradients up to 10°C).

# Preparation

All surfaces must be structurally sound, clean, dry and free from

surface contaminants such as grease, rust and dirt. If necessary, remove any organic growth i.e. lichen, with a fungicidal wash such as Bond It MOULD STOP.



Any blisters in existing felt should be split, rebonded and sealed. Any cracks or splits should be made good using TROWEL MASTIC.

# **Application**

Apply by brush or squeegee and scatter chippings immediately. Where possible lightly roll the chippings and brush off any excess after the adhesive has set (1-4 days, depending on the weather). CHIPPING SOLUTION has immediate resistance to rainfall.

Suitable chippings for use are flint, gravel, limestone, granite and white calcined spar.

# **Drying Time**

Drying times will vary depending on weather conditions and film thickness. Heavy applications will result in extended drying times.

# **Cleaning Of Tools**

Clean with paraffin (kerosene) or Bond It WHITE SPIRIT.

Colour

Black in colour.

#### Coverage

Coverage is dependant upon the size of the chippings to be bonded, approx. 1.8m<sup>2</sup> per litre for 3 to 9mm chippings, 1.3m<sup>2</sup> per litre for 12 mm chippings.

#### **Container Size**

Available in 5 and 25L metal tins.

# **Storage Life**

Minimum of 5 years under good storage conditions in original unopened containers.

# **Storage Conditions**

Store under cover away from sources of heat and ignition. Keep containers sealed when not in use.

# **Disposal of Containers**

Do not leave containers on site where residue could be a hazard to children, animals or the environment. Replace lids securely and remove any containers to a central disposal point.

# **Health & Safety**

Please refer to separate material safety data sheet for full handling, use and storage instructions. Keep out of reach of children. It is the users responsibility to determine suitability for use. If in doubt contact our Technical Department for advice.
